#### **Safety Considerations:**

In order to ensure the safety of parade participants and the public, please observe the following requirements:

- Exercise extreme caution when handing out candy. Small children often times dart out and pick up such items creating danger.
  - IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO THROW CANDY FROM YOUR FLOAT, PLEASE THROUW IT FAR FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CHILDREN
- All entrants must comply with State law governing motor vehicles. Drivers must be licensed for type of vehicle being operated. Helmets are required for motorcycles and bicycles.
- All vehicles, regardless of type, must be driven and ridden in a safe manner. Fishtailing, burnouts, and reckless driving will not be tolerated: any violation of this rule will result in vehicle/entrant being pulled out of the parade. Injuries to pedestrians will be the sole responsibility of the owners and or operators of vehicles.
- Reminder: No Horses nor horse drawn carriages. This is due to the smaller areas of the parade and overall safety of those enjoying the parade.
