Parade Rules & Regulations:

- ⇒ All parade participants will report to Adairsville Elementary School. Each participant will be placed in a specific classification, with this classification you will be assigned where to line up.
- ⇒ Each participant will be notified of by text, email or call to determine assigned area to line up (Franklin or King St.).
- ⇒ If you are entering as a group 1+ vehicles/floats you will need to arrive together. Participants are lined up as they arrive. The lineup areas are only used for lining up, no parking. Parking will be available at the Unity Center at the bottom of the hill.
- ⇒ Judging – a panel of judges will be walking around prior to the start of the parade and the winner will be announced once Santa reaches the square. The winner will be added to the trophy that is kept in the City Hall lobby. Additionally, your winning participating piece will be advertised on our social media outlets.

Parade Safety Considerations:

- ⇒ Exercise extreme caution when handing out candy. Small children often dart out and pick up these items, creating danger.
- ⇒ All entrants must comply with State Law governing motor vehicles. Drivers must be licensed for type of vehicle being operated. Helmets are required for motorcycles and bicycles.
- ⇒ All vehicles, regardless of type, must be driven and ridden in a safe manner.
 - Fishtailing, burnouts and reckless driving will not be tolerated.
- ⇒ No horses nor horse drawn carriages.
